






Telefonica Opens Wayra Incubator In London, Plans More In Europe







As demand for fixed voice services has waned, telcos' B2B market share has dropped accordingly. But that decline has now accelerated by 5% (or more) annually, in some markets, as more nimble information and communication technology (ICT) players step in to offer what B2B customers want: more digital interactions and improved pricing and packaging options, along with better customer service and problem resolution.

Mobile operator aims to refocus on data

Telefónica, the world's fifth-largest mobile operator by revenue, is to sponsor a series of European technology sites to house companies backed by its venture capital funds as part of a wider strategy to refocus the company on data.

Telefónica, which restructured last month to carve a separate division focused purely on digital business, plans to invest in technology start-ups and entrepreneurs to try to find the next wave of innovation. The Spanish company will cluster its partners in a number of connected technology sites planned in cities such as London and Munich.

Traditional mobile operators such as Telefónica face questions over their future given pressure on pricing at the same time as higher costs of infrastructure investment. Control of higher-margin data services – rather than providing the bandwidth for others to make money – is seen by analysts as one solution.

José María Álvarez-Pallete, who was appointed to head Telefónica Europe last month, said in his first interview that the company was being repositioned to focus its future on digital businesses. "We want to occupy the technology around telecoms. We need to take advantage of our proximity to the customer.

Incubators and accelerators: An updated directory for the UK

Key findings

- We identified 205 incubators and 163 accelerators currently active in the UK, <u>considerably</u> more than <u>previously estimated</u>.
- We find that corporate-funded programmes are now in the majority, with 51% of programmes receiving finance from this source. Furthermore, this trend for corporate funded accelerators appears to be growing very rapidly. VC funds now account for a small proportion of accelerators.
